

ICAAAI 2025 Research Submission and Review Policy

1. Paper Submission Process

Authors interested in submitting their research to ICAAAI 2025 are required to complete the official submission form and upload their manuscript in PDF format using the following link:

All submitted papers must strictly adhere to the conference formatting and ethical guidelines. Upon successful submission, authors will receive an acknowledgement email containing a unique Paper ID, which should be used for all future correspondence.

2. Initial Screening: Plagiarism and AI Content Check

Before the double-blind review process begins, all submissions undergo an initial screening stage to ensure originality and authenticity. This includes:

- Plagiarism Check using standard plagiarism detection tools.
- AI-Generated Content Analysis to assess the extent of AI involvement in manuscript preparation.

Evaluation Criteria

- Papers with combined plagiarism and AI content below 40% will be considered for the next stage of the review process.
- Papers with less than 10% plagiarism and AI content are regarded as high-quality original submissions and proceed directly to domain-expert review.
- If a paper exceeds the acceptable threshold, authors may be requested to revise and resubmit according to ICAAAI 2025 ethical and originality standards.

Only papers that meet these criteria will move forward to the double-blind peer review stage.

3. Double-Blind Review Process

All submitted manuscripts will undergo a double-blind peer review process to ensure fairness and impartiality. Each paper will initially be evaluated by two domain experts who will independently assess the submission based on its originality, quality, and contribution to the field.

4. Decision Criteria

• Acceptance:

If both reviewers recommend “*Strongly Accept*” or “*Accept*”, the paper will be accepted for inclusion in the conference proceedings.

• Additional Review Required:

If either reviewer provides a recommendation of “*Marginal Accept*” or “*Reject*”, the manuscript will be sent to a third domain expert for an additional independent review. The final decision will then be based on the combined evaluations.

- **Rejection:**

If both reviewers recommend “*Reject*” or “*Strongly Reject*”, the paper will be declined from further consideration.

5. Reviewer Feedback and Reports

For every manuscript, whether accepted or rejected the organising committee will share:

- Reviewer comments and recommendations
- Plagiarism and AI analysis reports

This is to ensure transparency and to help authors understand the feedback for improving their research work.

6. Acceptance Notification

Once a paper has been accepted, an official acceptance email will be sent to the corresponding author. This email will include:

- Registration details
- Important deadlines
- Instructions for preparing and submitting the camera-ready version of the paper.
